Application for the OIA Undergraduate Scholarship

You are eligible for this scholarship if:

- You were born outside the United States, regardless of citizenship, residency or national origin, and
- You are proficient in at least two languages, and
- You are able to demonstrate i) outstanding academic achievement, and ii) financial need.

Deadline: February 15, 2010. If you apply for this scholarship, you should complete your university application on www.applytexas.com or send a complete paper application to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions by Feb. 15, including secondary school transcripts, so your academic record may be considered as part of the scholarship selection.

This scholarship will be awarded for the academic year beginning August 2010. It may be renewed if the student maintains a grade-point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above *and* if the scholarship committee finds that financial need still exists.
